

CHILDCARE CHOICES

The Government have introduced a new scheme for parents to assist with Childcare, further information can be found on www.childcarechoices.gov.uk parents make their own choice by using the on line calculator which they enter their salaries/childcare costs etc and it will inform them of the best options:-

Tax Free Childcare:- is an on line payment account, whereby parents can pay into and the government will top up 20% to a maximum of £2000 per child per year (£4000 for a disabled child). Parents must be in work and earning at least £120 per week and not more than £100,000 per year

This will be gradually rolled out to parents to apply by the end of 2017.

30 hours' free childcare for 3 & 4 year olds from Sept 17. This doubles the existing 15 hours. Parents need to check on the website to see if they are eligible then submit an online application before Sept. Once signed up they receive an eligibility code to give to the Nursery, the nursery can then claim the funding. This needs to be done each term for funding if we don't receive the code then the parents will be invoiced.

Childcare vouchers will remain open to anyone to apply until April 2018, those parents already using schemes can continue and gradually as the children get older and no longer in childcare will be phased out.
